PROGRAM

Model Foundation is an international summer program on venture philanthropy and social innovation, with an emphasis on combining practice with theory.



Online Course & Due Diligence (Jul 1-Aug 7)

As a participant, you will take a 6-week online course with curriculum materials specially developed by PIM, sourced from Yale, Stanford, and The University of Hong Kong. You will be matched with local social enterprises in Greater China, gaining a deep understanding of their work through site visits and interviews.



Philanthropy Conference in Beijing (Aug 8-12)

A 1-week Philanthropy Conference, held at Yale Center Beijing, features guest speakers, interactive workshops, and career exploration. Participants present their findings and collectively manage a fund of 20,000 USD to support a portfolio of innovative social enterprises.



Alumni Community (Post-Aug)

Following the program, you can continue to receive mentorship in addition to social impact career development opportunities through PIM. As a community, alumni spread the notion of effective philanthropy among their peers.

Through Philanthropy in Motion (PIM)'s experiential curriculum and mentorship, young people develop the skills and networks to become effective changemakers and leaders in their communities.
