As an organization we do not directly engage in 'application consulting' or 'admissions consulting' for promising youth. - Coach debate and public speaking courses between 8 12 sessions per week (16 24 hours of coaching)
- Evaluate, revise, and implement curricula for LearningLeaders core disciplines: public speaking, debate, drama and critical reasoning
- Develop competitive debate curricula and training programs

In addition to coaching responsibilities, successful applicants will develop their leadership, project management, and intercultural communication skills through initiating new ventures within LearningLeaders. Examples of recent successful initiatives include:
